Rules and Requirements

A. Eligibility

1. Applicant must enroll in a college, university, or post-secondary institution during the Fall semester of 2016. Current high school seniors and college students are eligible.
2. Applicant must be an employee or a dependent of an employee of a Marek member firm. *(Preference MAY be given to those pursuing a construction related degree and if you will be first generation college graduate in your immediate family).*

B. Requirements

1. The applicant is responsible for insuring the all of the following items are received by the Marek Scholarship Committee by **March 4, 2016**.
 - >Completed four-page original application form
 - >Two letters of reference
 - >Official high school and/or college transcripts
 - >Essay from applicant titled: ***Why I Should Receive the Marek Scholarship***

C. Awards

1. The number and dollar amount of awards will be determined by the scholarship Committee. The minimum award will be \$1,000 and the maximum could be \$10,000.
2. The applications will be reviewed by the Marek Scholarship Committee. The committee will consider each applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, and financial need.
3. Some restrictions may be made on the use of the funds.
4. All scholarship recipients will be notified on or before April 29, 2016. **Scholarship funds will be disbursed upon receipt of proof of enrollment.**
